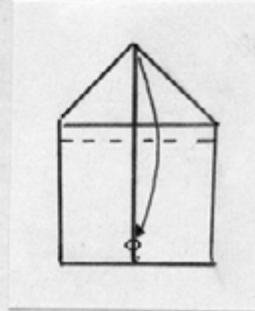

Fold the sheet in half, length-wise. Unfold so that the crease is a "valley".



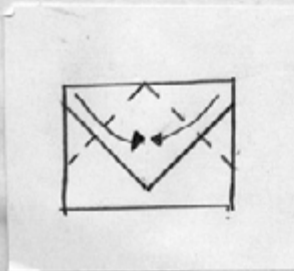
2.

Fold the top corners down to the center fold.



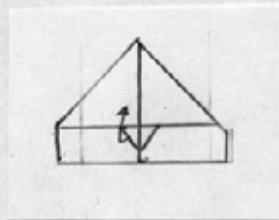
3.

Fold the tip down along the horizontal dotted line to meet the black dot.



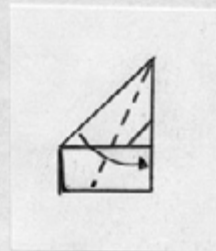
4.

Fold these new top corners down to the center vertical fold.

Fold the small tip up to form a lock.



6.

Fold in half so that the "lock" is underneath on the outside of the plane.

Fold the wings down, write a message, and fly!
